

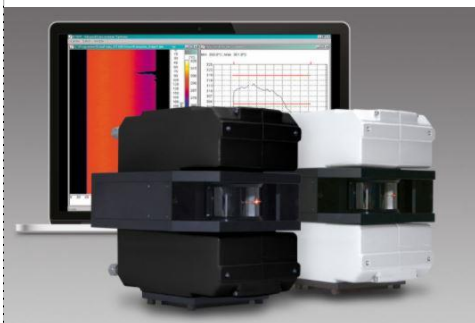


200 Years Ago
